


THE “HOLY FAMILY” EXPANSION OF COR JESU MONASTERY

Monastic life in the Catholic Church is a complete and all-encompassing dedication to God, where every aspect of existence—prayer, work, study, and silence—is ordered toward seeking union with Him. Rooted in ancient traditions, it demands a radical detachment from the world, shaping the monk or nun into a living sacrifice of praise. The Handmaids of the Precious Blood dedicate their entire lives to adoring Our Eucharistic Lord and making sacrifices for the good of priests worldwide.

Since their relocation to New Market, Tennessee, in 2015, the Handmaids were able to purchase a Christian retreat property in eastern Tennessee at the base of the Great Smoky Mountains, consisting of several retreat-modeled buildings.

Temporary remodeling efforts were performed to accommodate the sister’s immediate vocational needs, including private cells, oratories, and a small chapel in one of the garages. As the community continues to settle and grow, the time has come to provide more permanent and better facilities to accommodate the contemplative cloistered sisters’ lives of prayer. The “Holy Family” facilities expansion will help provide the community with a proper “place to pray, a place to heal, and a place to dwell.”



3 CORE ELEMENTS OF EXPANSION

A Place to Pray: Build a larger chapel where the sisters can gather as one community for Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration. This chapel will be handicapped accessible, giving all sisters much easier access to this holy space as the current Chapel is currently located nearly a quarter of a mile from the main living quarters. *(Projected cost \$1,750,000)*

A Place to Heal: Construct an infirmary to provide compassionate care for elderly and ailing sisters, allowing them to remain active in community life. Community life is a central pillar for the sisters regardless of the state of their health or their stage in life. *(Projected cost \$1,650,000)*

A Place to Dwell: Expanding the number of rooms will give all sisters a place to live, pray and work under one roof, enhancing their communal life and prayer. The Sisters require this dedicated space to maintain their life of silence, solitude, and contemplative prayer. *(Projected cost \$1,600,000)*
